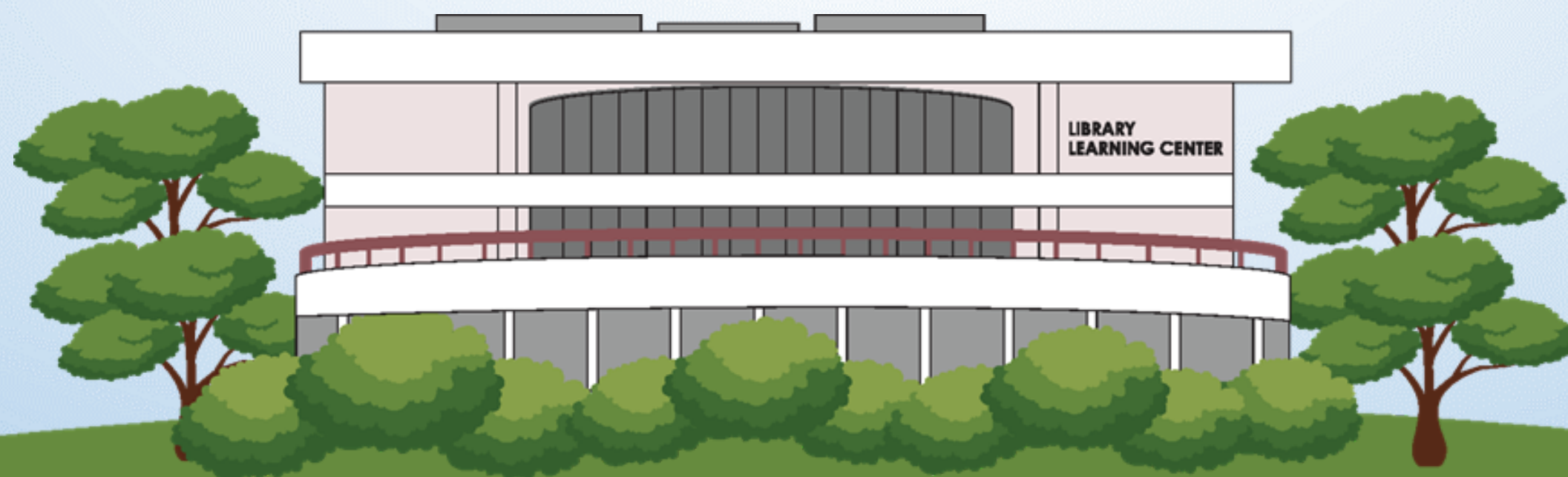

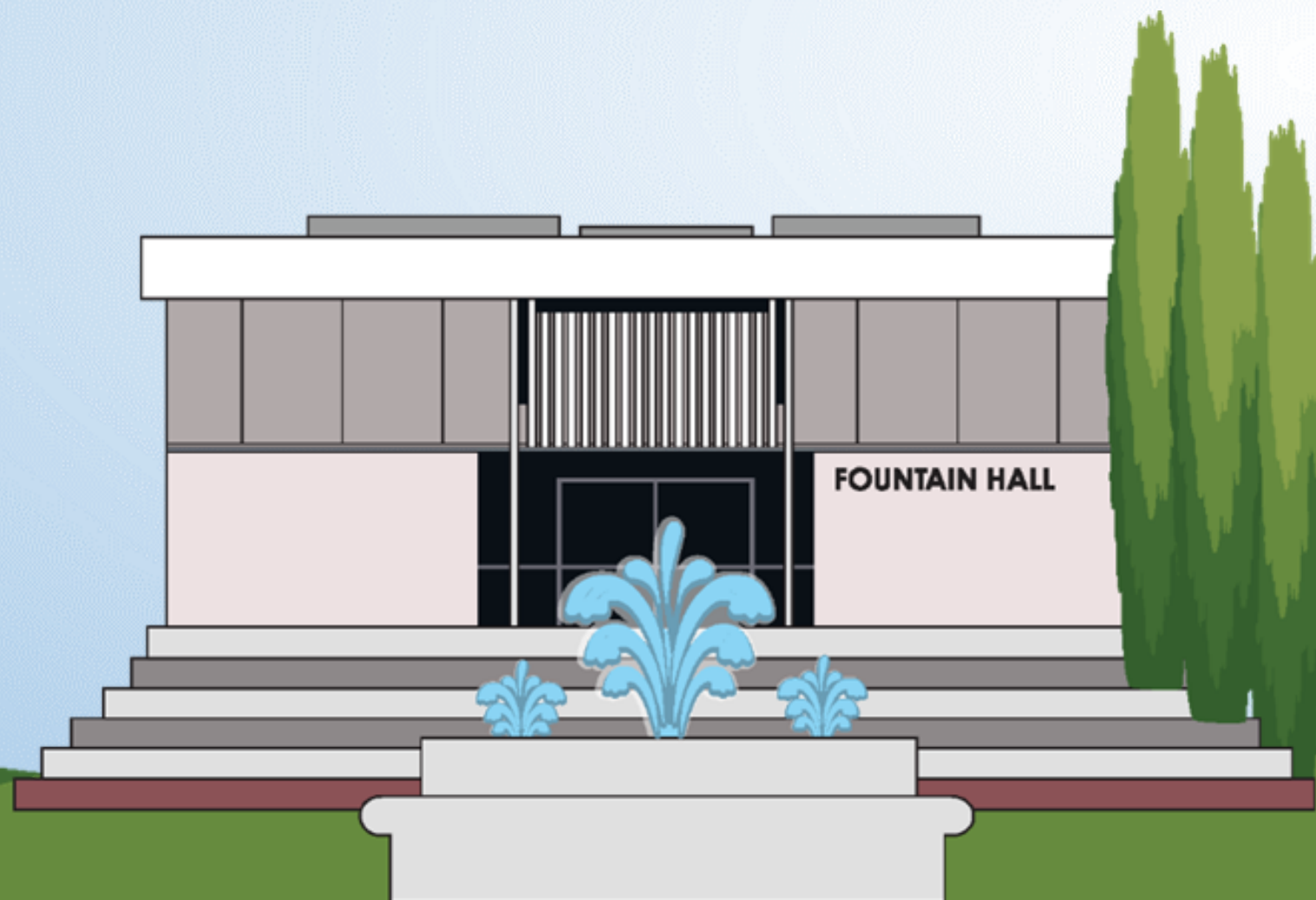

- Build connections and get support on campus

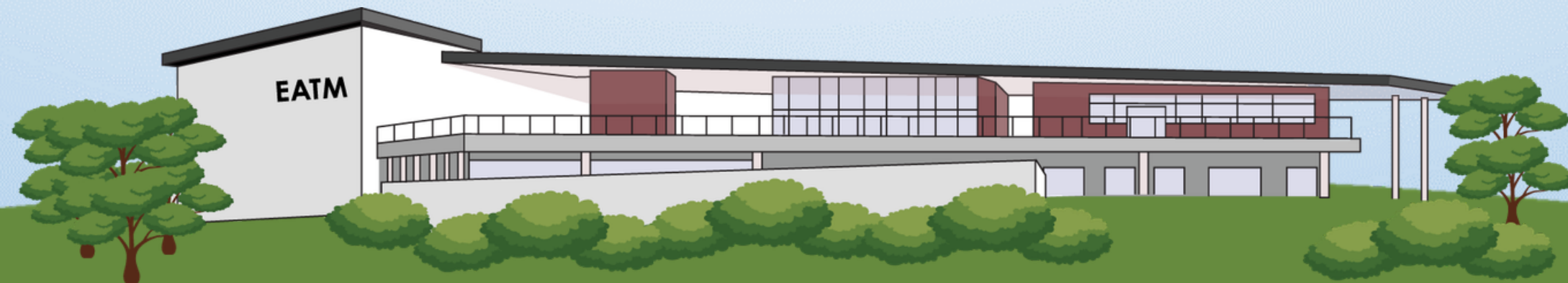

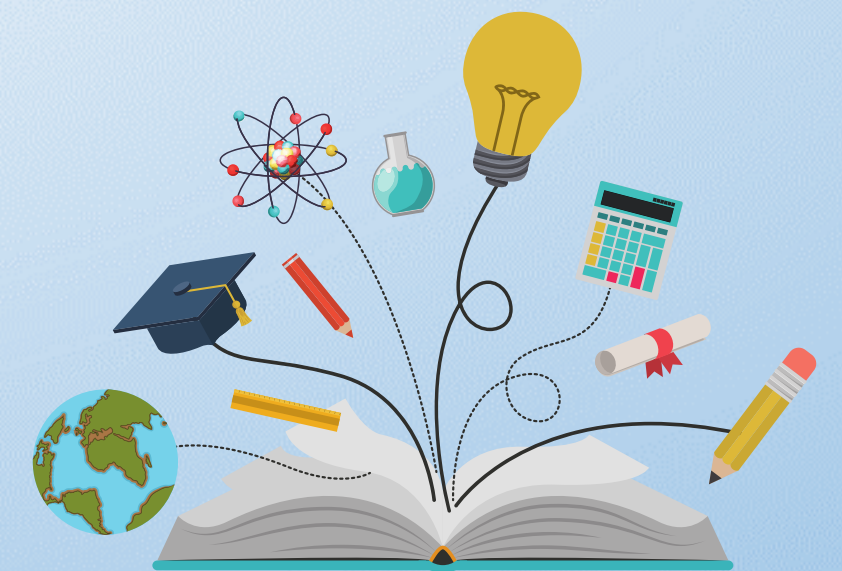
